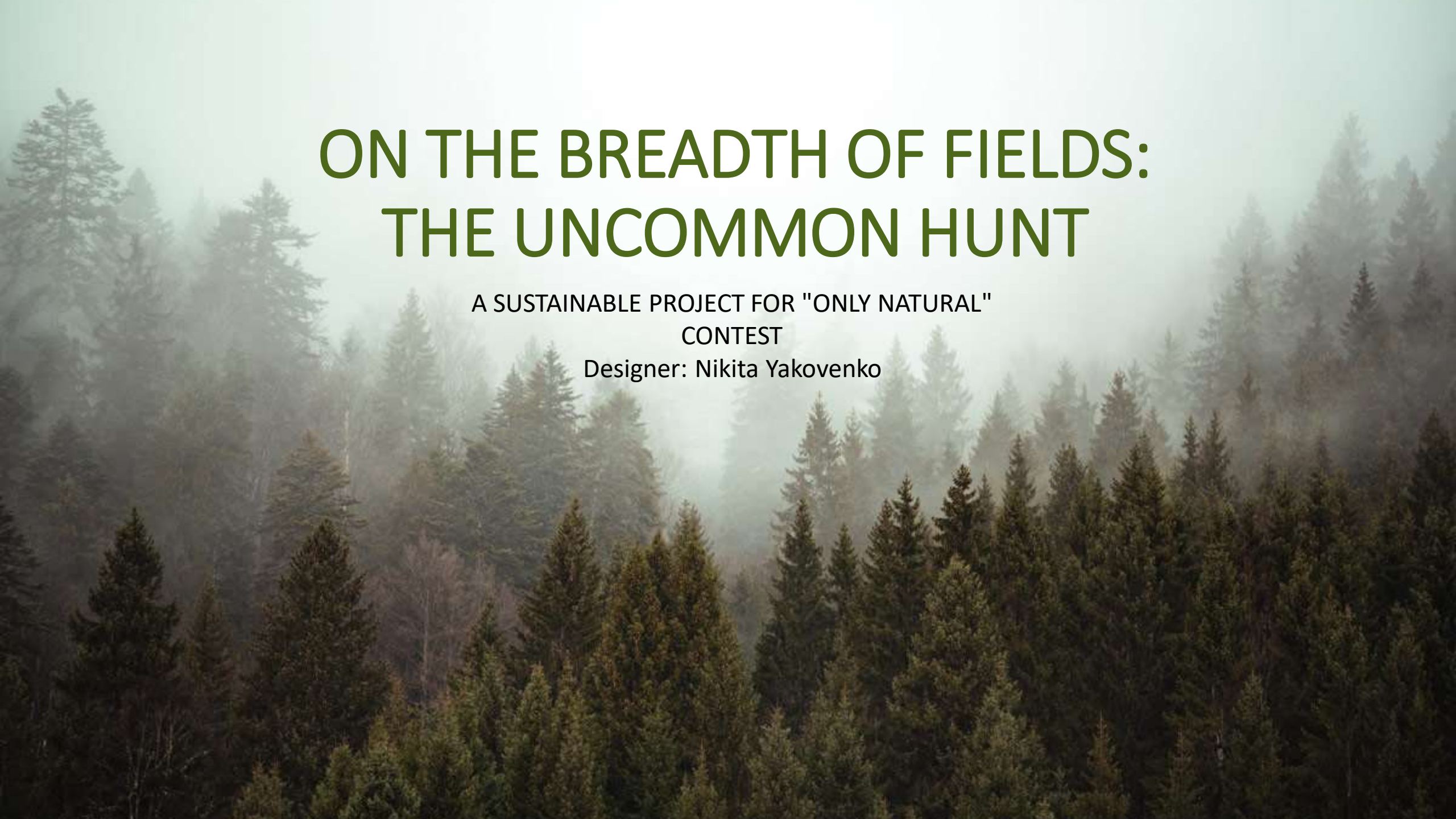




ON THE BREADTH OF FIELDS: THE UNCOMMON HUNT

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CONCEPT & VISUAL MANIFESTO

This project is an exploration of a woman's inner strength through the lens of eco-upcycling and military style. It stands as a manifesto of wildlife reclaiming its rights within the aggressive environment of the metropolis.

The visual language of the collection is built on the contrast of forms and textures. Protective, structured military silhouettes and functional utility elements meet organic, flowing lines.

Driven by the philosophy of sustainability, the garment integrates upcycled materials, including reconstructed second-hand textiles and recycled yarn. Complex handcrafted elements and intricate textures mimic natural structures, showing that even in a concrete jungle, the wild always finds a way to break through.

- The New Amazon:
- This look shatters the fragile stereotypes of femininity, bringing forward the archetype of a courageous, resilient "forest amazon" whose character is defined by bravery, internal strength, and a profound, raw connection to nature.

- Eco-Military & Biomimicry:
- In this look, the military aesthetic and camouflage are completely redefined. Instead of being tools of combat or human aggression, they are transformed into symbols of biomimicry and organic integration into the natural landscape.

- A New Breath:
- This look serves as a powerful manifesto of wild nature reclaiming its place and forcefully breaking through the rigid, gray concrete jungles of the modern city. It is a visual representation of life's unstoppable urge to grow and regenerate. Through raw, deconstructed edges, multi-dimensional textures, and layered upcycled elements, the garment captures the very moment where organic energy fractures the synthetic urban landscape.

TACTICAL SILHOUETTE

Tactical Silhouette & Botanical Camouflage:

The structured skirt and basque are engineered from heavy 100% organic cotton canvas and raw flax linen, forming a rigid, protective tactical silhouette. In alignment with the core values of sustainable design, the organic, leafy camouflage pattern is achieved through non-toxic botanical printing. This process directly infuses the garment with natural pigments derived from local flora, eliminating harmful synthetics. The design perfectly balances sharp, armor-like lines with the soft, unpredictable beauty of nature's true colors.

THE LIVING SWEATER



The Living Moss Sweater:

An avant-garde, conceptual art-piece that intricately mimics the rich, tactile texture of wild forest moss and grass. The garment is crafted entirely by hand using an innovative Zero-Waste Weaving technique. It gives a second life to upcycled cotton jersey scraps (reclaimed from old T-shirts), reinforced with a fluffy, dimensional blend of undyed raw wool and pure hemp fibers. Combining high-end conceptual design with a circular mindset, this piece is 100% biodegradable, proving that waste can be reimaged into haute couture textures.



MATERIAL SPECIFICATION

1

- **70% Upcycled Cotton:**
- Post-consumer cotton scraps reclaimed from old T-shirts and woven into a luxury textured structure. By giving a second life to textile waste, this material highlights the power of circular fashion—diverting discarded garments from landfills and transforming them into high-end, tactile design components.

2

- **20% Pure Wool:**
- 100% natural, undyed raw local wool, completely hand-spun to add a plush, organic volume and rich depth that mimics wild forest moss. By using unrefined, non-factory processed fibers, this material preserves the authentic tactile qualities of sheep's wool while keeping the carbon footprint minimal.

- **10% Wild Hemp:**
- Resilient hemp and raw flax fibers utilized to reinforce the sweater's structure and construct the intricate details of the basque. Serving as a solid, 100% biodegradable base, this organic fiber provides exceptional structural strength, ensures the durability of the silhouette, and anchors the garment's raw, untamed aesthetic.

CIRCULAR & SLOW DESIGN



- 100% Biodegradable

- Every thread, fabric layer, and structural element is meticulously engineered without a single trace of microplastics, synthetics, or polyester. Utilizing the artistic technique of visible mending as a design statement, the entire garment remains completely organic. At the end of its lifecycle, this piece can safely return to the earth, decomposing in the soil as nutrient compost without leaving a footprint or causing harm to the ecosystem.

- Visible Mending as a Living Concept:

- The organic, chaotic texture of the sweater allows for effortless, beautiful repairs over time, seamlessly weaving new threads directly over the worn areas. Instead of deteriorating, the garment transforms into an evolving, living art-piece that grows alongside its owner. This approach guarantees extreme product longevity, turning the signs of wear into a unique narrative of sustainability and continuous creation.
